Rebuilding Together Tulsa to repair 11 homes

Rebuilding Together Tulsa, a local nonprofit organization, will rally more than 400 volunteers to help repair 11 Tulsa neighborhood homes.

The volunteers will begin work at the homes selected for repairs on the morning of April 29 and will finish by the end of the day.

"It's exciting to be involved with a program like Rebuilding Together Tulsa, since the volunteer and sponsorship effort is quantifiable. For every \$1 donated, there is a resulting benefit of \$4 to the Tulsa community," Katherine Saunders, Rebuilding board president, said in a media release.

The Tulsa chapter is a part of the national organization that repairs homes in 480 cities and towns across the nation. Funding for homes repaired in Tulsa is provided locally.

Repairs that will be made include: new roofs, wheelchair ramps, new windows, sturdy door locks, smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, window repair, sheetrock replacement, electrical repair, plumbing repair, interior and exterior painting, and more.

Sponsors provide funding and volunteers to repair the homes. Bank of America is this year's title sponsor.
